Colonel Randy Boucher currently serves as the Chief of Staff and Military Deputy Director of the Center for Army Analysis, a Field Operating Agency of the Headquarters, Department of the Army G-8, located at Fort Belvoir, VA.

He was commissioned a second lieutenant in the Aviation branch in 1997. Colonel Boucher completed the AH-64A qualification course and served in assignments in 6-6 Cavalry Regiment in Germany and 1-6 Cavalry Regiment in the Republic of Korea.

Colonel Boucher served as an Assistant/Associate Professor of Mathematics at the United States Military Academy, West Point, New York (2006-2009 and 2015-2018) in the Department of Mathematical Sciences.

After his first tour at West Point, Colonel Boucher served as a Division Operations Research Officer in the 4th Infantry Division and deployed to Iraq in support of Operation New Dawn.

Most recently, Colonel Boucher served as a Division Chief for the Force Strategy Division at the Center for Army Analysis.

Colonel Boucher earned a Bachelor of Science degrees in Mechanical Engineering from Boston University, Master of Science degree in Applied Mathematics from the University of Washington, and PhD in Applied Mathematics from the Naval Postgraduate School. His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Aviator Badge, Airborne Badge and Air Assault Badge.
