Colonel Heather A. (Stevenson) Jackson currently serves as the Chief of Staff and Military Deputy Director of the Center for Army Analysis, a Field Operating Agency of the Headquarters, Department of the Army G-8, located at Fort Belvoir, VA.

She was commissioned a second lieutenant, branched Military Intelligence, in 1996. Colonel Jackson's Military Intelligence experience spans the tactical and strategic realms – 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 4th Infantry Division at Fort Carson, Colorado and Eighth Army Headquarters and 501st MI Brigade both in Yongsan, Korea.

Colonel Jackson served as a faculty member and assistant professor of Mathematics at the United States Military Academy, West Point, New York (2005-2008 and 2011-2014).

Since 2008, Colonel Jackson has served as an Operations Research Officer where her analysis has the supported strategic decisions of senior Army leaders in the Pentagon.
